Information about this children's home

The home is owned and operated by a private company. It provides care and accommodation for up to four children whose adverse childhood experiences can lead to them exhibiting complex behaviours.

There has been no registered manager since October 2021. A manager has been appointed and has made an application to register.

This monitoring visit

On 3 May 2022, Ofsted granted a condition of registration requiring the provider to give Ofsted three months' notice of their intention to move a child in to the home.

On 27 June 2023, the provider confirmed to Ofsted that they intended to reopen the home. The purpose of this monitoring visit was to assess the provider's readiness for children to move in to the home.

An experienced and qualified manager has been identified. This manager is a registered manager for another home operated by the same company. The manager has made an application to register as manager for this setting with the intention of maintaining her existing registration.

The home has sufficient staff to safely care for children. The manager has ensured that new staff have been thoroughly vetted and that their suitability to work with children has been assessed.

All staff have received an in-depth induction to their work, including training in key areas, such as safeguarding. There is an ongoing training programme to ensure that staff are suitably equipped with the knowledge and skills to support children and

meet their needs. Those staff who do not hold the diploma in residential childcare are enrolled, and anticipated completion dates are agreed.

The home has been redecorated to a high standard. The addition of soft furnishings has created a warm and homely feel. Each child's bedroom is bright and colourful.

Managers have ensured that the premises are compliant with health and safety requirements and that the home is a safe place for children to live.

As a result of this monitoring visit, the condition of registration requiring the provider to notify Ofsted of their intention to move a child in to the home has been removed.
