Information about this children's home

This home is operated by a private company. The home provides medium-term to long-term therapeutic care and support to children and young people who have suffered childhood sexual abuse and child sexual exploitation. The children and young people may also have emotional, social and behavioural difficulties. The home offers placements for a maximum of four female children or young people aged between 11 and 17 years.

The manager was registered with Ofsted in August 2019.

This monitoring visit

This home closed for a short time due to damage caused by water from the surrounding area. This visit is to assess the condition of the home and its readiness to reopen.

The provider has taken steps to improve the drainage around the home and has engaged the services of a professional company to make changes. Additional steps taken to divert water away from the home into the drainage system are effective. The home has had no further incidents of flooding. Improvements have been made to the access to the property.

During the closure, the provider analysed the skills and experience required by the staff to meet the needs of the children and young people who use the service. As a result, a new staff team has been identified and a deputy manager has been appointed.
