This home is registered to provide care for up to four children with learning difficulties.

The home registered in January 2018. Children have never lived in this home.

The home is without a manager.

This monitoring visit

The purpose of this visit was to ensure that the imposed suspension notice was being adhered to. Additionally, it was to review the action taken by the responsible individual to meet the one requirement raised at the last monitoring visit on 12 April 2023.

There continues to be no children living at the home. Therefore, the suspension notice has been adhered to.

The home environment is homely and warm. The responsible individual has maintained a welcoming home with decorative features such as ornaments and high-quality furniture.

Since the previous monitoring visit, a manager and staff team have not been recruited. The responsible individual has been unable to recruit staff for the roles. This has prevented the quality of staff's training and experiences from being reviewed. As a result, regulation 13 has not been met.

Since the monitoring visit, the responsible individual has decided to voluntarily cancel the registration of the home.
