This home has a three-month condition, which means no children have lived in the home during this period. The purpose of this monitoring visit was to assess the suitability of the home before children move into the home.

Information about this inspection

This inspection was carried out under the Care Standards Act 2000.

The home has recently been refurbished to a high standard. Children's bedrooms are equipped with matching furniture, new carpets and beds, creating a comfortable and personalised space. The bathroom is modern and newly fitted, and the kitchen is integrated and well maintained.

The home is welcoming and well presented, both internally and externally. The garden areas are well maintained and provide children with space to play and engage in outdoor activities.

Recruitment files reviewed during this visit were compliant with regulatory requirements. Leaders and managers are trained in safer recruitment practices. They apply this knowledge effectively to ensure that all staff employed to work with children are subject to appropriate vetting and checks, thereby promoting children's safety.
