Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- Leaders maintain good oversight of the camp. They ensure that there are robust procedures in place to check the suitability of staff. Leaders explain how they provide effective support, supervision sessions and training to help staff to fulfil their roles and responsibilities. This includes knowing how to keep children safe and well.
- Leaders describe how they plan the programme of activities. They discuss how staff offer a broad range of experiences to cater for children's different ages and interests. Leaders explain how the daily routines include opportunities for children to be physically active, to explore the outdoor environment and to enjoy quieter activities, such as yoga and art. Staff aim for children to have lots of fun, learn new things and practise what they can already do.
- Leaders understand the importance of healthy lifestyles for children. For instance, they say that staff provide a wealth of sports and games, which encourage children to be physically active, alongside regular opportunities to rest and refuel. Leaders explain how staff supervise children at mealtimes and use discussions to teach them about healthy eating.
- Leaders explain how staff support children's positive behaviour, such as through clear and fair rules and boundaries which are shared daily between staff and children. They discuss how this helps everyone to be clear about expectations, such as being kind and respectful towards others.
- Leaders say they value their partnerships with children's parents and carers. They describe how staff keep parents informed about the camp activities and are available to discuss children's individual needs and experiences. Leaders seek feedback to enable them to evaluate and develop the provision, so that children enjoy their time at the camp as much as possible.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
