

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

Our reference 5291257/2497279

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 26 October 2022, the provider notified us of a significant event. This notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events and changes.

On 12 December 2022, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Action needed by 23 December 2022:

- develop knowledge and understanding of changes and significant events to notify Ofsted and the required timeframe to do so.

On 23 December 2022, we received a response from the provider in relation to the action raised. The provider now understands their responsibilities to notify Ofsted of changes and significant events and when this must be done. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
