

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 29 April 2026, the provider notified us about an incident in relation to safer eating. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage to notify Ofsted of significant events where a child or children may have been at risk of harm.

On 13 and 14 July 2026, we conducted regulatory telephone calls. On 15 July 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found that the provider had failed to adhere to safer eating requirements. In addition, we found that the provider had previously failed to follow all their roles and responsibilities as a Designated Safeguarding Lead. However, they have taken swift and appropriate action to correct this. The provider has taken steps to ensure all staff, including leaders, are aware of all their roles and responsibilities in line with requirements. They have provided additional training to ensure that all policies and procedures are clearly communicated and fully embedded amongst the entire staff team. The provider has put additional measures in place to ensure that all paperwork is appropriately reviewed and signed. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
