This privately owned home provides care for up to four children with emotional and/or behavioural difficulties. No children have lived in the home since 28 June 2021.

The registered manager's position has been vacant since 1 February 2021.

This monitoring visit

This visit was scheduled to be undertaken as a full inspection. However, when the inspector arrived, he found that the home was unoccupied. The responsible individual came to the home and told the inspector that the home has not operated since the last child moved out on 28 June 2021.

All care staff have been made redundant and the company that operates the children's home is no longer active with Companies House. However, the provider has not informed Ofsted of this change. Consequently, the service remains registered with Ofsted.

The responsible individual confirmed that he will make formal contact with Ofsted to request to voluntarily cancel the home's registration.
