

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On the 11 April 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to Staff to adult ratios, Suitable people, Health, Qualification and training, support and skills. On the 14 April 2025 we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 1 May 2025

ensure that minimum adult to child ratios are met at all times and there is at least one member of staff with a full and relevant level 3 qualification, and at least half of all other staff hold a full and relevant level 2 qualification caring for children at all times.

On 6 May 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit we found that the provider had met the action set in the welfare requirements notice. The provider had improved the staff to child ratios and supervision of staff. The information gathered suggests that the provider is now meeting the requirements of their registration. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
