

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2

If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 23 April 2026, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, training and skills, supervision of staff, staff: child ratios and whistleblowing.

On 16 June 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements relating to safeguarding policies and procedures. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 22 June 2026:

- ensure that all staff know and understand the safeguarding policies and procedures to follow to keep children safe, specifically when they have concerns

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action is successfully completed. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of complaints

We publish details of complaints made against childminders, home childcarers and childcare providers where we or the provider have taken action in order to meet legal requirements.
