

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 23 March 2026, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to staff: child ratios, concerns about children's safety and welfare, and safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment.

On 3 June 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found that the provider was not meeting one of the requirements and they took immediate action to put this right. The provider has reviewed and amended their risk assessment in the baby room. They have replaced a barrier used to separate the large room with a safer alternative. This measure has reduced the risk of harm to young children occupying this room.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
