

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 30 April 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures and concerns about children's safety and welfare.

On 14 May 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 28 May 2025:

- take action to ensure safeguarding policies and procedures are implemented effectively, particularly in respect of managing allegations about adults who work with children.

On 15 May 2025, the provider responded to the action set. They have reviewed and updated their safeguarding policies and procedures and shared them with staff. This includes clear and concise actions to be taken if an allegation is made against adults working with children. Additionally, the provider has organised further training for staff to enhance their knowledge.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
