Summary of key findings

This provision does not meet requirements

- The childminder has not maintained an appropriate paediatric first-aid qualification. Her previous training has expired. She has done some first-aid training online, to help maintain her knowledge. However, this does not meet the required standards for effective paediatric first aid. This potentially compromises children's safety.
- The childminder completes relevant safeguarding training. She knows how to recognise the signs of abuse and neglect. The childminder is confident about the processes to follow, should she have concerns about children's welfare or if an allegation is made about her.
- The childminder describes how she will support healthy lifestyles for children. For instance, she will implement good hygiene routines, such as regular handwashing. The childminder plans to teach children about healthy eating and the benefits of exercise and outdoor play.
- The childminder knows how to plan an ambitious curriculum for children, based around their interests and next stages of development. She explains how she will adapt activities for children of different age groups and abilities.
- The childminder describes how she will monitor children's learning. She explains how she will discuss any concerns about children's progress with their parents and help them to access additional support where needed.
- The childminder understands the importance of working in partnership with parents. For example, she says she will share information on children's learning and give them advice on how to support this at home.
- The childminder explains how she will promote children's good behaviour and help them to understand her expectations. She knows how to be a positive role model and to teach children about kindness and respect for others.
- The childminder recognises the importance of providing an inclusive service. She knows that children have different cultural backgrounds and experiences. She explains how she will help them to understand their similarities and differences.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

What does the setting need to do to improve?

To meet the requirements of the early years foundation stage, the provider must:
