

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 23 March 2026, the provider notified us about risk assessments. The notification means that on this occasion the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 1 May 2026, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reviewed and improved their risk assessment for the supervision of children and the safety of premises, including when using the garden area. This helps to ensure children remain safe during outdoor activities.

During the telephone call, we also identified that the provider failed to notify us of two additional significant events that had previously occurred. This means that the provider has not met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
