Information about this children's home

This is a privately owned home. It is the only home owned by this provider.

The home can provide care and accommodation for up to four children with emotional and/or behavioural difficulties.

The manager is suitably experienced and has recently registered with Ofsted.

This monitoring visit

This home is newly registered and has not yet had an inspection. Following an initial period of operation, the home was temporarily closed for several months to allow for improvements to be made and for management arrangements to be strengthened. This monitoring visit was undertaken following the admission of a child into the home. The purpose of the visit was to assess the quality of the admissions process and ensure that the quality of care is appropriate.

The admissions process has improved. Information was gathered from a variety of sources and a number of professionals working with the child. This informed the decision to offer a place to the child at the home.

Risk assessments are detailed and include clear strategies to support the child. The social worker also provided detailed information about risks and vulnerabilities prior to the child moving in to the home. This means that staff working with the child have a good understanding of how to keep the child safe.

The placement plan is detailed and clear. It supports staff to understand and meet all of the child's needs. The placement plan also provides information to staff about how best to engage and support the child.

The child has settled well into the home. Online education is provided, and the manager is working with other professionals to access a school placement. Activities are offered that reflect the individual interests of the child. Staff are building positive relationships. The child is able to identify adults that they could speak to if they had any concerns.

The physical environment is clean and homely. Children placed at the home are encouraged to personalise their bedrooms.

Appropriate safety measures are in place to manage risks associated with the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic.
