

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 8 May 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to staff: child ratios and the safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 6 June 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reviewed risk assessments and taken additional steps to ensure all children always remain accounted for when on outings. The provider has also ensured they have strengthened the information they obtain from parents about their children to inform their ongoing risk assessments and procedures. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

In addition, during this regulatory visit, we found the provider was not meeting one of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take

Action needed by 23 June 2025:

- take action to ensure Ofsted are notified of changes to the committee, so the suitability of new members can be checked and verified.

On 15 June 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider has improved their knowledge and in turn, has put appropriate steps in place to ensure any changes to the committee are notified in a timely manner, to ensure individuals can be checked and their suitability for role verified. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare action raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
