The home is privately run. It is registered to provide care for up to two children aged between 11 and 18 years who may have social, emotional and behavioural needs. There were no children living in the home at the time of the monitoring visit.

The manager has been registered with Ofsted at the home since October 2020. She manages both this and another of the provider's homes.

This monitoring visit

The purpose of the monitoring visit was to establish if the provider has made suitable arrangements for the home to resume operating following a period of closure. The home continued to be registered with Ofsted during the period of closure but was taken off the inspection programme. No children have lived at the home since December 2021.

External monitoring has been maintained, and the responsible individual has kept Ofsted up to date about the developments at the home. During this period, the provider has invested in refurbishing and updating the premises. The environment is warm and nurturing. It has been decorated and furnished to a good standard throughout.

The provider has demonstrated that they have suitable resources to resume operation in line with the home's statement of purpose. The provider is ready for children to move in.
