

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 10 October 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to suitable people, paediatric first aid, staff: child ratio, safety of premises and risk assessment.

On 7 January 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. Furthermore, during the visit we found the provider had failed to notify Ofsted of a previous significant event within the required timescale. This is an offence, however, on this occasion Ofsted are not taking further action.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 16 January 2026:

- maintain a record of the identity checks and vetting processes completed for all staff
- ensure that all fire detection systems, including smoke alarms, are properly installed and maintained to remain in working order
- ensure records are easily accessible and available to those who have a right or professional need to see them.

On 15 January 2026, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of maintaining records relating to the identify and vetting checks for staff. They have reviewed and improved the fire detection systems to ensure that smoke alarms are installed and maintained effectively to promote children's safety. The provider has reviewed how they ensure records are easily available and accessible, to those who have a right or professional need to see them. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
