

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 4 February 2025, the provider notified us about a change that must be notified to Ofsted. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of such changes or events.

On 17 March 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found new concerns that the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. These were unrelated to the notification from the provider. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 19 March 2025:

- ensure that the procedures for risk assessments are robust and identify any potential hazards, such as cleaning materials, and store them safely out of children's sight and reach.

On 21 March 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had improved the storage of cleaning materials and other hazardous items, to ensure they remain out of reach of children. The provider had ensured that items are removed from the stairs and other spaces that children access, to prevent trips and falls. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
