

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 December 2023, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 20 December 2023, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 29 January 2024:

- develop effective behaviour management strategies that support children's emotional well-being and helps them learn how to regulate their feelings and behaviours.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action is/are successfully completed.

On 30 January 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of how to manage children's behaviour effectively. However, during the regulatory visit, we found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The new areas of concern were in relation to the childminder ensuring children are adequately supervised and always in sight or hearing distance. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
