

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 3 July 2025, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

The overall effectiveness of the provision was judged to be inadequate. The inspection report sets out the actions the provider was required to take to meet the requirements.

On 2 September 2025 we carried out a regulatory telephone call. The focus of the call was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection. We found that the childminder had improved their knowledge and understanding of safeguarding policies and procedures and understood who to make the appropriate referrals to if there was a concern about a child or an allegation against a household member. The childminder has now followed the correct procedures in notifying Ofsted of any persons who work directly with children. She has also completed paediatric first aid training. The childminder has strengthened her knowledge on welfare requirements such as key person and risk assessment to ensure children's individual needs are known and met. Also, that children are safe and secure in the environment. In addition, the childminder now ensures that drinking water is accessible to children at all times to access independently.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
