

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 10 February 2025, the provider notified us about a change to their registered address. The notification is a requirement of registration, however, the provider failed to notify us within required timescales. This means the provider has breached their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage. Changes that must be notified to Ofsted.

On 17 March 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We discussed that the provider had failed to keep Ofsted up to date with a significant event as they did not inform Ofsted of a change to the address of the premises where they provide childcare or seek approval to operate from those premises. The provider confirms they are now clear about the process for making notifications to Ofsted.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

### **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
