

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 25 January 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements relating to suitable people, safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment and supporting and understanding children's behaviour.

On 29 January 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have served a welfare requirements notice. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 2 February 2025:

- ensure the kitchen is adequately cleaned to allow the hygienic preparation of snacks, meals and drinks
- ensure resources and household equipment such as mirrors, are positioned and secured to prevent the potential of any risk of harm to children
- carry out robust risk assessments to ensure children are not exposed to risks on the premises
- take action to prevent unauthorised people entering the premises.

On 3 February 2025, we found that the provider had met the actions in the welfare requirements notice. They had made significant improvements to ensure children can be cared for in a safe and secure environment.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services

we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
