

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 June 2025, the provider notified us about a significant incident in relation to accident and injury. However, this notification was not made within the 14 days as required. It is an offence to fail to notify Ofsted of a significant event within the prescribed timeframe. Following further discussion, the provider demonstrates an increased understanding their responsibility to notify Ofsted within the stipulated timeframes. As such, on this occasion, Ofsted will not be taking any further action.

On 24 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has reviewed and taken action to strengthen their risk assessment to ensure children's safety. In addition, the provider took immediate steps to ensure local child protection agencies were notified of any serious accident or injuries to any child while in their care. They also ensured all senior leaders were fully aware of the requirement to do so.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
