Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The provider is committed to providing high-quality, inclusive care for all children and their families. They are aware of the importance of ensuring that all children, including those with special educational needs and/or disabilities, benefit from full access to the provision.
- The provider has a good range of play resources and equipment that are suitable for a broad age range of children.
- The provider recognises their role in teaching children how to behave, including valuing and respecting others. They acknowledge the importance of setting clear boundaries to help guide children's behaviour.
- The provider understands the importance of teaching children about healthy lifestyle habits. For example, the value of eating well-balanced meals, following good hygiene practices and the importance of physical activity. They describe appropriate arrangements to encourage children to make healthy food choices.
- The provider recognises the importance of building strong relationships with parents. This includes seeking their views on the quality of the provision to help drive improvement.
- The provider understands their role in safeguarding children. They know that they are responsible for ensuring that staff receive regular training to help them to recognise when a child may be at risk from abuse and/or neglect.
- The provider understands the importance of evaluating the provision to identify areas for improvement. They are committed to ensuring that staff keep their knowledge and skills up to date. For example, staff attend regular training to help guide and improve their practice.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.
