Information about this children's home

The home is owned and managed by a private provider. It is registered to provide care for up to one child who may have social and emotional difficulties, physical disabilities, learning disabilities, mental health difficulties or a sensory impairment. The home was registered in July 2023.

The manager was registered in February 2025. This was the home's second visit.

This monitoring visit

The home has not provided accommodation to children since its registration. The manager resigned from their role soon after registration. Due to difficulties with recruiting staff, Ofsted imposed a three-month condition, meaning the provider must give notice to the regulator of its intention to care for a child.

The provider gave Ofsted notice that it is ready to care for a child. This visit focused on whether the provider continues to meet its statutory requirements to maintain its registration and is ready to accept placements.

The home environment remains warm and inviting and is ready to welcome a child. The manager has plans to tailor it further to any child who moves in, so it is personalised for them.

The provider has appointed a new manager and a staff team and has taken sufficient steps to be ready to provide care to a child once the required safer recruitment checks are fully complete.

The purpose of this visit was to monitor the action taken and the progress made by the children's home since its last Ofsted inspection.
