The home is owned and managed by a private provider. It is registered to provide care for up to one child who may have social and emotional difficulties, physical disabilities, learning disabilities, mental health difficulties, or a sensory impairment.

The home was registered in July 2023. The manager was also registered in July 2023. This is the home's first inspection.

The home has not provided accommodation to children since its registration on 14 July 2023. This inspection focuses on whether the children's home meets its statutory requirements in order to maintain its registration and is ready to accept placements.

The home environment has a warm and friendly feel and is decorated and furnished to a high standard. However, the provider does not have a staff team to work in the home, so children are unable to move in.

What does the children's home need to do to improve?

Recommendation

- The registered person should ensure that the home has sufficient staff to provide care for each child; also see regulation 13(2)(d), the leadership and management standard. Sufficient staff means a home having enough suitably trained staff, including someone in a management role, on duty to meet the assessed needs of all children in the home, and that those staff are able to respond to emergency placements, where accepted.
