Summary of key findings

This provision meets requirements

- The provider explains how she helps children to feel happy and secure. She understands how to plan a play environment to engage and motivate children.
- The provider discusses her understanding of the importance of working in partnership with parents and carers, schools and outside agencies to help to provide continuity in children's care. She explains this enables her to meet children's needs and ensure continuity in their care.
- The provider describes how her and the staff team manage children's behaviour. She explains they have high expectations for children's behaviour. The provider explains that staff help children to manage their own feelings and support them to follow the clear rules and boundaries they set. She understands how to teach children to show respect for each other and to develop the social skills to enable them to enjoy positive relationships.
- The provider explains how important it is to promote children's good health and well-being. She discusses the importance of providing children with a healthy and balanced diet. The childminder describes how they offer children plenty of opportunities to practise their physical skills. She discusses how children have regular access to the adjacent school playground, where they can play ball games, run and play.
- Parents of older children who attend the club say that they are delighted with the service provided. They say that their children are exceptionally happy, enjoy the range of activities available and the opportunities to play at the end of a busy school day.
- The provider discusses how she has an ambition to continually improve the club. She explains how her, and her team, are determined to provide children with the very best play and learning experiences they possibly can. The provider demonstrates that they have the highest expectations to provide the best experiences for children.

There were no children in the early years age range present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no early years children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke to parents during the inspection and took account of their views.
