

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 14 August 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to Suitable people, Staff:child ratios, Supervision of staff, Safeguarding training, Food and drink, Risk assessment, Information and record keeping, Information about the child and Qualifications, training, support and skills.

On 3 September 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action that requires the provider to take the action below within the timescales set out. The provider was able to give parents further information about this. The provider was still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 18 September 2025:

- obtain suitable references for all members of staff before they are formally recruited and begin work in the setting.

On 18 September 2025, the provider did not provide a response to the action raised. However, the provider notified Ofsted of their wish to resign their registration. Consequently, we closed the actions to allow us to resign their registration. They are no longer a registered childcare provider.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
