## **This monitoring visit**

This visit took place following escalating safeguarding concerns and Ofsted having received a whistleblowing complaint.

When the visit was announced, access could not be gained to the home, as there were no staff present. The registered manager and responsible individual were both absent from work. There were no children residing in the home at the time.

The provider subsequently requested to cancel the home's registration. The cancellation was accepted by Ofsted, and the home is no longer operating.
