Information about this children's home

This home is managed and run by a private company. It provides care for up to three children who may experience social and emotional difficulties.

There are no children living at this home.

There is no registered manager.

This monitoring visit

This children's home was judged inadequate at the full inspection on 20 and 21 May 2025. Two compliance notices relating to regulation 12 and regulation 14 were issued under section 22A of the Care Standards Act 2000.

On 17 June 2025, an early monitoring inspection was undertaken to address serious concerns raised by the provider. During the visit, the inspector identified serious and widespread concerns about the care and protection of children. Ofsted took immediate action to suspend the home on that day.

The purpose of this monitoring visit was to consider the actions taken by the provider to meet the compliance notices issued following the inadequate inspection.

Most of the staff have left their roles, and the two remaining staff members have transferred to another home within the company. There is currently no registered manager in place, and the home is being overseen by the responsible individual.

The provider has outlined plans to recruit a new manager and staff team. Once appointed, the new team will undergo a comprehensive training programme to

ensure that they fully understand their roles and the expectations placed upon them, particularly in regard to safeguarding and child protection.

Despite these plans, leaders and managers have not taken sufficient action to meet the steps set out in the compliance notices.
