Monitoring visit

Inspected under the social care common inspection framework

Information about this children's home

The home is owned and managed by a private provider. It offers care for up to 3 children who may experience social and/or emotional difficulties.

The home was registered with Ofsted in October 2025. A new manager has submitted her application to register with Ofsted. The fit person's interview and suitable person's interview for the responsible individual were also completed at this visit.

This monitoring visit

Ofsted imposed a condition on this home on 5 September 2025 under section 13 of the Care Standards Act 2000. The condition is that the registered person must inform Ofsted of their intention to accommodate children in the home at least 3 months before any child is accommodated. This measure was introduced as the directors of the organisation had been clear that they did not intend for any children to move in until they have made changes to the home environment and recruited new leadership and a more experienced staff team.

The provider informed Ofsted of their intention that children will move into the home. This visit took place to consider the removal of the condition.

Since the condition was imposed, the provider has recruited a new manager and responsible individual. Both have previous experience of managing children's homes. In addition, the whole staff team has changed, with leaders focusing on recruiting experienced staff.

The manager will now be supported by a deputy manager, 3 team leaders and 3 support workers. All have come together to complete relevant face-to-face and online training to ensure that they have the skills and knowledge required to meet the children's needs. The manager has been working through quality assuring the

recruitment checks as she was not in post when staff were recruited. Work is ongoing in this area.

The home environment has been improved and there are further plans to continue to improve the standard. All relevant health and safety checks have been completed to ensure that the home itself is a safe place for children to live in. The manager has also considered any risks in the local area.

Following this monitoring visit, a case review was held on 10 March 2026, where it was agreed that the condition could be removed. The manager and responsible individual have also been deemed suitable.
