

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 22 January 2025, the provider notified us about: Staff:child ratios, Safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment and Information and record keeping. This notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 30 January 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found that the provider was meeting some of the requirements and not others. We found that there were sufficient numbers of staff caring for the children. Additionally, we found that the provider conducts effective risk assessments which help them ensure that the premises is safe and suitable. Furthermore, we found that the provider has suitable arrangements in place to manage accidents and injuries, and that they keep required information and records.

We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 27 February 2025:

- provide staff with training to help them to fulfil their roles and responsibilities to keep children safe, particularly in relation to the supervision of children
- ensure that at least half of staff working with babies have completed training that specifically addresses the care of infants.

On 25 February 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved the support and training for staff in relation to understanding their roles, in particular, to help them ensure that children are supervised effectively. Additionally, we found the provider had trained staff in the care of babies. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
