

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 13 May 2025, the provider notified us about an incident linked to Safeguarding policies and procedures, Staff: child ratios, and Safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 3 June 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider had taken some action to address a breach of requirements by strengthening their risk assessments. However, the provider was not meeting all requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take.

Actions needed by 20 June 2025:

- ensure staff are deployed effectively to supervise children closely in all areas of the premises, to promote their safety and well-being.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action is successfully completed.

On 19 June 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had taken effective steps to improve staff deployment and the supervision of children. They have

made changes to their organisation and routines to ensure staff always supervise children closely. In addition, they have strengthened measures to promote children's safety and well-being. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
