

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 24 June 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to concerns about children's safeguarding and welfare.

On 29 October 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has taken steps to ensure that suitability checks are completed to enable staff to fulfil their roles. This supports children's safety and well-being.

We also found the provider was not meeting some other requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take.

Action needed by 26 November 2025

- improve the knowledge and understanding of staff who hold leadership roles to ensure they follow the setting's policy and local safeguarding partnership's procedures for reporting any concerns.

On 25 November 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of child protection procedures. We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
