

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 8 May 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to the safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of significant events.

On 23 May 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. This was followed up with a further regulatory telephone call on 30 May 2025. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take.

Action needed by 13 June 2025:

- ensure ratio requirements are met in order to meet the needs of all children so that they are supervised effectively and kept safe.

On 3 June 2025, the provider responded to the action set. Ofsted requested further information, which was sent on 15 June 2025. We found that the provider had reduced the number of children they care for to ensure that ratio requirements are met at all times.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
