Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder demonstrates a clear understanding of the learning and development requirements. She provides a wide range of resources and activities to promote children's all-round learning.
- The childminder promotes healthy lifestyles well. She provides plenty of opportunities for exercise, healthy meals and good hygiene practices.
- The childminder shows a good awareness of safeguarding procedures and knows who to contact if she has a concern about a child's welfare.
- The childminder uses self-evaluation forms to reflect on the strengths of her practice and identify areas for improvement. This helps her to effectively prioritise plans for future developments.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

Inspection activities

- The inspector conducted a tour of the premises during the inspection.
- The inspector had a discussion with the childminder.
- The inspector observed older children during activities indoors.
- The inspector sought the views from parents through discussions.
- The inspector looked at a range of relevant documentation relating to safeguarding, policies and procedures and learning and development.
