

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 July 2025 we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 16 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We continued to liaise with the provider and requested relevant documentation.

On 30 January 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We continued to correspond with the provider following this visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and we then took action in relation to this. We issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 14 February 2025:

- provide Ofsted with evidence of an application for an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service check for the nominated individual

The provider responded to the action satisfactorily. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
