

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 28 March 2024, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting some of these requirements.

On 9 May 2024, we carried out a regulatory telephone call. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 30 May 2024:

- implement effective procedures to make sure all those looking after children are suitable, including notifying Ofsted and ensuring they have the relevant training to fulfil their roles and responsibilities
- ensure at least one person has a full and relevant paediatric first aid certificate when caring for children at all times
- ensure safeguarding policies and procedures are understood and followed, particularly managing allegations about adults who work with children.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the actions are successfully completed.

On 20 May 2024, the provider responded to the actions set. We found that the provider had improved their knowledge and understanding of the procedures to follow in the event of an allegation being made against a household member. The provider will ensure that any assistants left in sole care of children have the relevant paediatric first-aid qualification and are suitable to fulfil their role.

We are satisfied the provider has met the safeguarding and welfare actions raised. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
