

Complaint about childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the 'Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage', which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 28 April 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to health, qualifications, training, support and skills, key person, staff-to-child ratios, safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment and safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment.

On 30 May 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider has strengthened procedures for managing children's specific dietary requirements to ensure that children who have food allergies, intolerances and preferences are not provided with food that is not safe for them to eat.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.
