

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundationstage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 12 September 2023, the provider notified us of a significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider or any person who cares for, or is in regular contact with children on the premises. However, the provider had not notified us within the required timescales which is a requirement of their registration.

On 18 September 2023, we carried out a regulatory visit to gather more information. This was followed up with a regulatory telephone call on 4 October 2023. No further action is required.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
