Summary of key findings for parents

This provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a suitable awareness of how to support children's learning and development. She has a range of toys and activities within her home that complement the seven areas of learning.
- The childminder understands the importance of observing and tracking children's learning, and the need to support their development from their starting points.
- The childminder comprehends how to manage children's behaviour, and is confident in her roles and responsibilities to safeguarding children.
- The childminder recognises the importance of good partnerships with parents and other professionals involved in children's care, to maintain and promote continuity in care.
- The childminder has successfully addressed her last inspections recommendations, which shows a strong commitment to improve her practice.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
