## Summary of key findings for parents

### The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a clear knowledge of her responsibilities to safeguard children. This includes the procedures to follow should she be concerned about a child's welfare.
- The childminder understands the benefit of reflecting, monitoring and evaluating the quality of her setting, to continually make improvements.
- The childminder values the importance of building partnerships with parents and other professionals, to provide consistency in children's learning and care experiences.
- The learning environment is safe and welcoming, and includes a range of toys and resources suitable for children of different ages.
- The childminder knows how to use the information from detailed observations and assessments to monitor children's development and to plan next steps, so children make the best possible progress in their learning, in preparation for school.
- The childminder understands how to promote children's well-being, be a positive role model, and teach children about how to respect one another and value differences.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children. The report states whether the provider continues to meet the requirements of registration.

## Inspection activities

- The inspector spoke to the childminder about her practices and procedures, including how she intends to deliver the educational programmes for children.
- The inspector viewed the areas of the premises that are available for childminding and discussed safety arrangements.
- The inspector looked at samples of documentation and records that the childminder plans to use to support children's welfare and learning.
- The inspector held discussions with the childminder about her systems for self-evaluation.
