

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 23 December 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to safeguarding policies and procedures, concerns about children's safety and welfare, staff: child ratios and safety and suitability of premises, environment and equipment. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event.

On 7 January 2026, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements. We have issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 27 January 2026:

- ensure that the correct safeguarding procedures are followed when any allegations are made against staff, including sharing information with the relevant agencies
- ensure the designated safeguarding lead has the necessary knowledge and skills for their role, including how to respond to allegations, in line with local safeguarding partners' procedures
- ensure the written complaints procedure is followed, with full investigation of each complaint and a clear outcome available to share.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action/s is/are successfully completed. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our

responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
