

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the [Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage](#). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right. On 11 June 2025, we received concerns that this provider was not meeting some of these requirements. On 29 August 2025, we carried out an unannounced regulatory visit. We found that the provider has reviewed and changed the procedures they follow if a child sustains an injury. We also found that staffing arrangements do not always fully meet children's needs at times when the setting is busy. Following this visit, we issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

■ Actions needed by 10 September 2025:

ensure staffing arrangements meet the needs of all children to make sure they are adequately supervised and kept safe at all times, particularly at times of the day when the setting is busy, such as pick up times for children.

On 9 September 2025, the provider responded to the actions set. They have reviewed their staffing arrangements at times when the setting is busy to ensure children and parents are adequately supervised. New procedures have been shared with staff and parents. The provider has explained how they will oversee that the procedures are implemented effectively. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
