

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

On 22 May 2025 and 12 June 2025, the provider notified us about matters relating to staff: child ratios. The notification means that the provider met their legal responsibility as set out in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage to notify Ofsted of a significant event which is likely to affect the suitability of the early years provider to look after children.

On 22 July 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting some of the requirements and had taken action to put this right. The provider had revisited the settings transition procedures to ensure that these are robust when moving children through the setting and out into the garden, including additional headcounts that are conducted. Review of policies, procedures and risk assessments relating to keeping children safe had been revisited and shared with staff. Further training had been implemented to ensure staff fully understand their duty to adequately supervise children and effectively keep them safe.

The provider will be able to give parents further information about this. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
