Summary of key findings for parents

The provision meets requirements

- The childminder has a comprehensive understanding of how to implement the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage. She is committed to her professional development and attends regular training to keep her knowledge and skills up to date.
- The childminder understands her role and responsibilities to keep children safe. She has a good knowledge of safeguarding to promote children's welfare.
- The childminder knows how to plan stimulating play activities that provide children with challenge and excite them to motivate them in their learning.
- The childminder has a good understanding of how to promote children's personal, social and emotional development effectively.
- The childminder understands the importance of being reflective in her role to continuously improve outcomes for children.

There were no children present when this inspection took place. The findings in this report are based on evidence gathered from discussions with those who care for the children and an inspection of the premises, equipment and relevant documentation. Where there are no children present, no judgement is made on the quality of the early years provision as there is no reliable evidence on which to assess its impact on children.
