

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 6 June and 13 June 2024, we carried out an inspection and found the provider was not meeting some of these requirements. The report and inspection outcome will be published in due course. Following the inspection we served a welfare requirements notice on 17 June 2024. This is a legal notice that requires the provider to take the actions below within the timescales set out. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Actions needed by 21 June 2024:

- ensure that all staff, including the designated safeguarding lead, have a good understanding of the safeguarding procedures, including how to record and act on concerns about children's welfare

- improve the monitoring, support and coaching for staff to ensure they use appropriate strategies to manage children's behaviour consistently and effectively.

On 24 June 2024, we carried out a regulatory visit. The focus of the visit was to check whether the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions, raised at their last inspection that were required to have been completed by 21 June 2024. We found the provider had met the safeguarding and welfare actions.

Leaders and staff have completed training and share how they implement strategies to manage children's behaviour effectively in line with the providers behaviour management policy. Procedures for safeguarding have been reviewed and additional training has been completed for the designated safeguarding leads. Leaders can demonstrate a clear understanding of how to respond and monitor safeguarding information for children in their care.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
