

## **Compliance action taken for childcare provision**

### **Summary of outcome**

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at [www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2](http://www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2). If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 24 June 2025, we received concerns that the provider was not meeting requirements relating to EYFS requirement supporting and understanding children's behaviour.

On 20 August 2025, we carried out a regulatory visit. We found the provider was not meeting one of the requirements. We have issued an action for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

Action needed by 1 September 2025: ensure that all suitability checks are completed for directors before they have access to confidential information and records about staff, children and parents.

We will monitor the provider's response to ensure the action is successfully completed. The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

On 12 September 2025, the provider responded to the action set. We found that the provider has ensured Ofsted has been informed of all directors to ensure suitability checks can be completed.

We are satisfied the provider has met the actions raised.

## **Publication of compliance action**

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.
