

Compliance action taken for childcare provision

Summary of outcome

All early years providers must meet the legal requirements in the Statutory framework for the early years foundation stage, which you can find at www.gov.uk/government/publications/early-years-foundation-stage-framework--2. If we find that a provider is not meeting the requirements, we can take action to ensure they put matters right.

On 22 November 2022, we completed routine suitability checks.

On 7 February 2023 Ofsted carried out a telephone regulatory call to discuss the concerns received. During the regulatory call new areas of concern were identified. This means the provider was not meeting other requirements as set out in the statutory framework for the early years foundation stage.

We issued actions for the provider to take. The provider will be able to give parents further information about this.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Actions needed by 17 February 2023

- gain an understanding of the various Local Safeguarding Partners (LSP) and who to contact to report concerns about a child or allegations are made against yourself or anyone in your household
- develop knowledge and understanding of safeguarding issues to enable you to identify signs and concerns of abuse and respond in a timely and appropriate way
- gain knowledge on matters that require notification to Ofsted.

On 14 March 2023 the provider responded with the actions she has taken to meet the requirements set above. She undertook relevant training which improved her knowledge and understanding of the requirements. We are now satisfied that the provider has taken effective action in order to meet these.

The provider is still registered with Ofsted.

Publication of compliance action

We aim to ensure that the welfare of children and young people is protected in the services we regulate. The Childcare Act 2006 and accompanying regulations set out our responsibilities to regulate childminders and childcare providers. This includes the enforcement powers we have in relation to those registered providers who do not comply with the requirements for registration.

We publish details of any actions we take, or the childminder or childcare provider takes to bring about compliance with requirements on our website for a period of five years.
